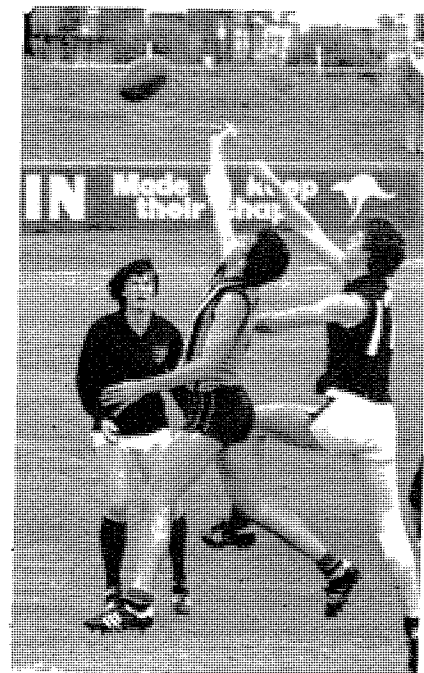

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

President of the active V.A.F.A. Umpires' Association was Darryl Hill, supported by Graeme Halbish as secretary and David Hindle as treasurer.

200 games to Ralph Bourke, "Clubman of the Year", for Ivanhoe in 1976.

De La Salle (A) and Marcellin were level at half (time, only to see De La Salle kick 13.6 to Marcellin's 2.4 in the second half. McDonnell, Halasa, Sykes (De La Salle) and J. Gartner, Frazer, F. Aloisio (Marc.) were best.

Uni. Blacks 5th (A), kept their final four chances alive when they withstood a desperate last quarter by Ormond (4th) to win by 3 points. Stars were Perrett, Burne, Llewellyn (Blks.) and Murphy, J. Russ, Corhen (Orm.).

250 games and 15 seasons to North Old Boys President Les Murray, twice best and fairest, leading goalkicker nine times, and V.A.F.A. representative in 1966, 1968 and 1969.

150 games to Tim Kurth (St. Bede's), Murray Smith (Alphington), Barry Hamilton (Old B'ton), Andy Curtain (E'wick) and 200 games to Roger Morgan (Old Carey).

Fawkner (C) continued on their winning way with a 95 point win over Hampton Rovers in which Foley, J. Teasdale and Ward starred.

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

30 YEARS AGO — 1952

Best for Blues were Geoff Tunbridge (later a half-forward flank star in Melbourne's premier teams), Rick Morrison and Mick Eggleston, while for Old Scotch Dave Hilliard and Tom Adams starred.

Third and fourth teams in the junior section, Melbourne High and Old Scotch met with High winning 8.9 to 5.11.

Among the notes — "highlight of the match was Brian Dixon's display of marking in the first half (made the selector's faces red)".
